Dear Middle School Band Parent,

We are excited to announce our annual MS Band Night, where our middle school band students have an opportunity to perform with the high school band. Our Wind Ensemble and Symphonic Band members are hard at work learning some challenging high school music. Performing with the HS Band is a great opportunity for our students to see what HS Band is like.

The event takes place October 28, 2022. Band students will perform stand tunes in the bleachers with the HS Band members at the Varsity Football game. Participating students are expected to be on time at 5:30 PM at the Freshman Center Band Hall (old CMS Band Hall). Students should be dropped off at the community center (not the band hall). Students will walk from the community center to the band hall and tailgate party. Large instruments will be delivered to the game for students. We will have 2 pick up times for students – 9:30 and 10:30 PM. You will decide your pick up time in the registration form (See OR code below).

The evening will begin with a tailgate party. Food and water will be available for all band members. After the tailgate party, students will enter the football field with the HS Band and perform in the bleachers throughout the game. MS Band members will also perform with the HS Band during halftime, however they will not march. Students will return to the bleachers at the beginning of the 3rd quarter to play until their pick up time.

Students have three attire options for the evening:

- Students can wear school-appropriate jeans (not shorts) and some sort of Crandall shirt.
- Students could also wear a Halloween costume. Costumes must meet school standards, must not be offensive in any way, and must allow students to play their instruments (no masks).
- Participating students may also elect to receive a complimentary band shirt to wear with school-appropriate jeans.

This is not a required performance, but we need to know in advance who is attending. Please complete the form using the QR code on the next page, as well as the permission slip. Since the game is a UIL event, students must be academically eligible to participate. To be eligible, a student must pass all of their classes (grade of 70 or above) during the first marking period.
