#### Special Instructions for Concert Band:

### Special Instructions for Wind Ensemble:

Wind Ensemble 8th graders will take their benchmark test in the morning, and eat lunch in their testing room. 7th grade members will eat lunch at their normal time. Students will be dismissed to the band hall at 1:30 to load and leave for contest. Several students have a tennis match following contest. We are working with the coaches, and making arrangements so that students can attend both events.
