

Crandall High School Band Policies, Expectations, & Student Pick Up



Policies and Expectations

- Members are expected to actively attend all band events listed in the yearly calendar.
- Band performances are included as grades in the band class. Students missing a performance due to a director-approved emergency will be given an alternate assignment. *See Eligibility*
- Members are required to have all equipment, instruments, music and necessary accessories for class. Not having all materials in class could reflect on their grade.
- Members are required to practice individually in addition to group rehearsals to ensure each student upholds their part in the ensemble.
- Members respect other members. This applies to teachers, sponsors, guest clinicians, and the student leadership chain of command (Drum majors, Section leaders, Squad leaders).
- Members are required to abide by all Crandall ISD policies both on and off campus.
- Members are expected to maintain all materials: instruments, music, equipment, uniforms, etc. Any fees assessed due to lack of maintenance must be paid before students regain access to said materials.
- Members that miss rehearsal time (excused or otherwise), may be asked to refrain from performances.
- Throughout the season, audio recordings, videos and photos of the band and individuals will be taken and published both online and on various media.

Student Pick Up Policy

We kindly request that parents and guardians wait for students in the student parking lot following events to ensure that buses have access to the designated drop-off areas within the bus loop. Additionally, we request that you refrain from blocking the sidewalk (marked with a "no parking" sign) at the rear of the band hall to allow the band truck to maneuver and unload safely.

Student safety is our utmost priority. As part of this commitment, we request that parents promptly collect their children following all band events. We acknowledge that pick-up times after events may not be consistently predictable. Therefore, we ask your student to contact you 30 minutes prior to the designated pick-up time. This information will be communicated on the buses during our return journey. In the event of a home football game, students are responsible for contacting their parents at the conclusion of the third quarter.

The following guidelines are in place to protect students and our directors from being at the school for extended periods of time after events:

- Parent and guardians are required to collect their children within 15 minutes of dismissal.
- Students will be required to call again at 15 minutes. The director may ask to speak to the parent or guardian.
- Thirty minutes after dismissal, a call will be made to Crandall Police, reporting that a student has been left at the school and requesting the presence of an officer to provide supervision until the parent arrives.
